Enter the county name where the notarization is taking place.

Enter the affiant name (the person swearing to the affidavit).



The affiant, signs the affidavit after swearing to the truthfulness of the statements in the document.

The affiant signature is followed by a jurat notarial certificate. Write in the actual date that the signer personally appeared before you and you completed the notarization.

You, the notary, will sign your name exactly as it appears on file with the Secretary of State, and affix the official notary seal.
